
## St. Brigid Baptismal Bibs

2 yards of white fabric can make 16-20 bibs. Fold fabric and cut out bibs in the following manner to maximize the use of the fabric:



- Press under ¼ inch along the raw edge around neckline. Slash around the curves. Sew close to edge.
- Press under ¼ around entire outer edge. Sew lace around this edge, with raw edge of lace on wrong side of bib. It takes about 1-1/4 yd of lace for each bib.
- The red cross can be made in many different ways:
  - o Satin stitch by machine
  - o Hand embroider using outline, chain stitch, etc.
  - Fuse 2 red strips of fabric or ribbon using Heat & Bond, Wonder Under, etc.
  - o Draw a cross using red fabric paint.
  - O Any other method you can think of.
  - Contact Diane Berdis at 770-642-7350 to machine embroider the St. Brigid cross. With enough lead time you can contact her to arrange to drop off your completed bibs to her.
- Press bibs nicely and bring to the Church Office.
