OUR VIBRANT PARISH

For more than two decades, Saint Brigid Catholic Church has served the spiritual needs of Catholics in the North Atlanta area. We are a thriving faith community with over 4,300 families, blessed with active lay leaders and dynamic ministries. We are passionate about our mission of gathering in worship as people of God to become more Christ-centered in our lives and actions.

OUR CHALLENGE

Our existing parish facilities have served us well. But we have added ministries and organizations since these facilities were built, and they are no longer large enough for our needs. We lack the room to accommodate the parish's 80+ ministries and organizations seeking space for meetings, activities and fellowship. Scheduling a meeting or event can be difficult due to space limitations. Our limited space hinders adding ministries and expanding existing ones, such as our youth ministry programs for example. Expanding our parish facilities could significantly increase the potential of our ministries and programs, as well as fellowship efforts.

OUR VISION

After careful study and discussion, parish leadership has identified a project intended to address our challenge and to position Saint Brigid for generations to come.

CONSTRUCT THE PASTORAL LIFE CENTER

Initial estimates show construction costing \$10 million. The parish through good stewardship, has already set aside approximately \$4 million in anticipation of this project. This means we would need to raise approximately \$6 million to carry out the project.

This large, free-standing, two-story pastoral center will be an investment in the spiritual vitality of our parish and strengthen our efforts to enhance our faith and fellowship. It will also serve as a legacy to our children and grandchildren. The new center will enable us to add new ministries and expand existing ones, assuring the parish will continue to be vibrant and flourish. With 23,000 square feet, the center will provide ample meeting, event and gathering space.

However, it is worth noting that this project is about more than bricks and mortar. The center will become the social and ministry hub of our campus, a place where parishioners of all ages will grow in faith and fellowship.



The new pastoral life center project will provide:

- A second floor dedicated to Life Teen and other youth programs
- A large and flexible first floor for parish events and gatherings
 - Meeting rooms for all ministries
 - State-of-the-art audio visual systems
 - Catering kitchen
 - Outdoor amphitheater
 - SVDP pantry and work space
 - Covered drop off areas
 - Upgraded handicap access
 - Enhanced sound systems
 - Increased parking
 - Improved parking lot traffic flow
