The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, Year A
June 13-14, 2020



This Sunday we celebrate the great solemnity of Corpus Christi, the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. We focus especially on this day on our devotion to the Eucharist, the source and summit of our faith, a faith united and rooted in community.

However, this sense of communal unity is not reflected in our nation at the present time. As we have seen from the recent tragic events in Minneapolis, and the resulting violence and civil unrest throughout our nation in recent weeks, there is still much work that needs to be done to bring unity, peace and healing to our nation. We continue to be wounded and divided in many ways. In a recent address, Archbishop Jose Gomez, president of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, called for healing and stated, "Today more than ever, we need a spirit of peacemaking and searching for nonviolent solutions to our problems." He also stated, "When God looks at us he sees beyond the color of our skin, or the countries where we came from, or the language that we speak. God sees only his children – beloved sons and daughters." We are challenged to take these words to heart.



The need for healing is reflected in the following prayer. The substance of this prayer has been composed by Texas Pastor Max Tyner, who addressed the pain and conflict which existed in our nation at a prior time. It has been adapted and slightly modified to more closely reflect the recent tragic events in our nation.

A Prayer for National Healing

Gracious and Loving God, we come as your children with sorrow in our hearts, and lives which are confused and disturbed. Recent weeks have brought death, anguish and distress to so many people.

We pray, O Lord, that You will heal this nation. Give peace and comfort to those who are in sorrow. Give healing and strength to those who have suffered injury and hurt at this time. Be with those who are working under such difficult circumstances. Give wisdom and guidance to the president of this nation and be with the political leaders as they make grave decisions necessary at this time.

We ask, Lord, that you heal us, as a people, that we may join hands and work together for the good of all. Grant us the wisdom and faith to see that only in You are true love and joy ever found.

Where we have wandered from Your will, put us back on the path You would have us follow. Where we have bitterness and hate, give us love and consideration for others and from the ashes of hate and destruction, may we rise up as a nation committed to Your teachings and Your will and a light to the world. This we ask in the name of Your son Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior. Amen.

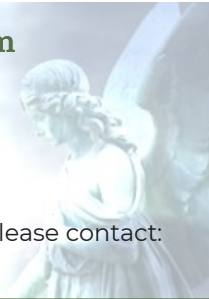

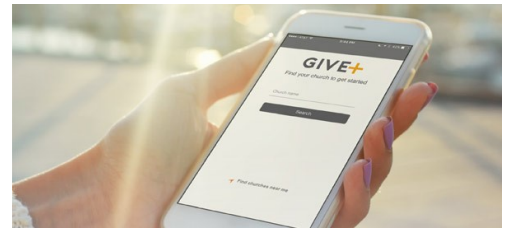

It is with much joy and humble thanks that we announce that our RCIA and RCIC elect and candidates will receive their Sacraments at a special Mass in their honor on June 17 at 7 PM. Please pray for them as they move forward to fully embrace the Catholic faith .

Last August, a group of teens, and children came to us (with their parents) seeking to learn about our Catholic faith. Many of these children were baptized as infants, but did not receive First Communion and Reconciliation when they came of age; some were baptized into a Protestant religion; some were never baptized. After a period of initial searching these children and their parents made a commitment to pursue formation that would lead to reception of the Sacraments and membership in the Saint Brigid community. They have been attending weekly sessions which focused on the Biblical unfolding of Salvation History. Through these stories of God's relentless reaching out to humankind throughout the Old Testament, they have learned of God's unending love and care for us, as well as His faithfulness to His promise to make us heirs to His Kingdom.

These children and families are so dedicated to their

mission of learning and growing in faith, that they continued their study after the termination of in-church classes that began in March, **virtually**, never missing even a week of formation; thanks to the help of dedicated volunteer catechists. The lockdown on church attendance and classes would not interfere with their commitment to grow in faith.

And when they completed the original curriculum, they went on even further, covering topics such as the Divine Mercy story and devotions, The Blessed Mother's role in our salvation, Lectio Divina, and the Biblical underpinnings of the Mass.

These groups, and their families have weathered the COVID-19 storm, and the changes that it brought to their lives. They came through transformed, by the power and the grace of God

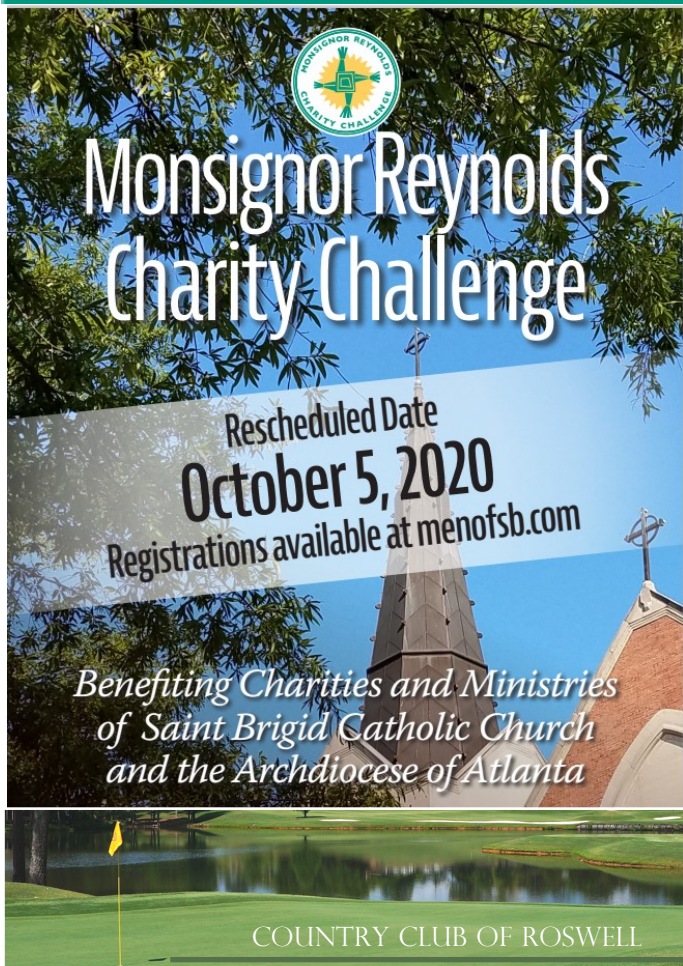

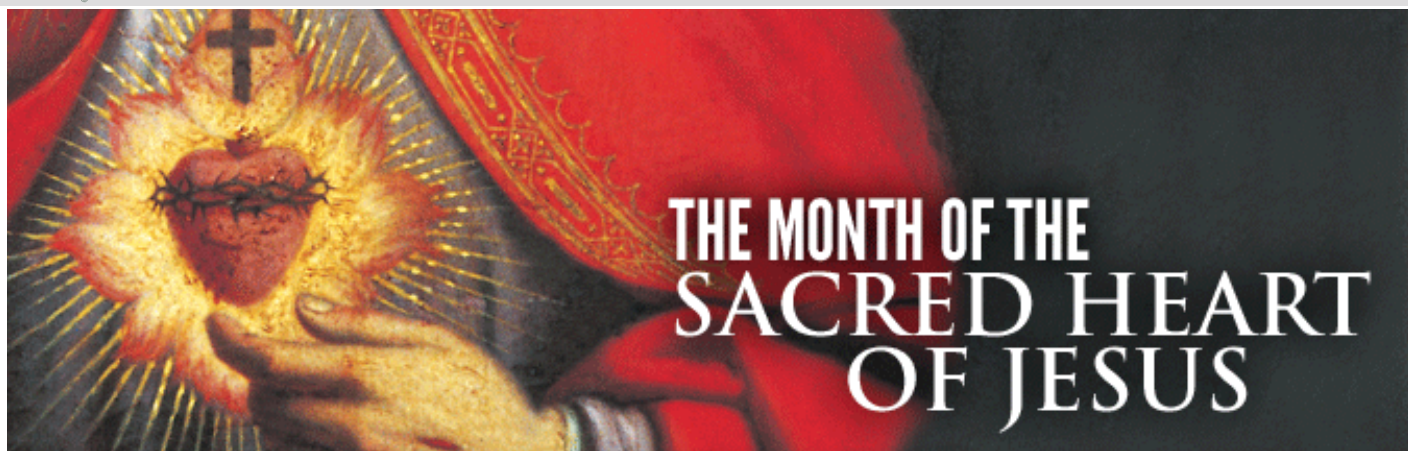

June is the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

The Sacred Heart of Jesus is the visible representation of Christ's love, divine love manifested in a human way, that love of Christ manifested in a very remarkable way in His love towards His closest friends. Is it more virtuous, more Christian, to love relatives and friends more than others?

"[The Son of God] worked with human hands, He thought with a human mind, acted by human choice and loved with a human heart"

-Gaudium et spes, no. 22]

Jesus Christ loved with a human heart. Pope Pius XII's encyclical, *Haurietis aquas* (1956), asserts that, from the moment of his conception in Mary's womb, the Savior's heart was formed, and it beat with a love at once human and divine. Jesus' heart was filled with pity for the widow of Nain (Lk 7:13); it was moved with compassion at the sight of the crowd who were like sheep without a shepherd (Mt 9:36); and it throbbed with sorrow at the death of Lazarus (Jn 11:35). In these movements of Jesus' human affectivity, the Incarnate love of God is made known to us.

Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus brings the mystery of the Incarnation close to us. It gives us direct contact with the love of God in the beating heart of His Son. And like every encounter of love, we become "undone" at the core of our being. In the presence of Divine love, all of our selfish, inordinate affections are dispelled and we begin to love as He loved (Jn 15:13).

Holy Mother Church exhorts us to consecrate ourselves and our world to the Sacred Heart because it is "a symbol and a sensible image of the infinite love of Jesus Christ which moves us to love one another" (*Annum sacrum*, 8). In Jesus, we are called to respond to God's love with our entire being, as individual and social persons. For this reason, religious freedom is vital. When the government seeks to coerce believers into violating their conscience, it is saying: "You can believe what you want, but in your action, you must do what we say." In this way, it introduces a division between our private lives and public lives.

Of course, we are integral wholes. Our actions manifest our minds and hearts. When the Church works in areas like healthcare and adoption, she is expressing her love for God and His world in a concrete, public way.

The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart fittingly falls during [Religious Freedom Week](#) this year. Religious freedom is essential for the mission of the Church, which "is not only to bring the message and grace of Christ to men but also to penetrate and perfect the temporal order with the spirit of the Gospel" (*Apostolicam actuositatem*, 5). As we work to meet the challenges of our time, may we draw our strength in hope through our encounter with the Sacred Heart of Jesus Christ.
