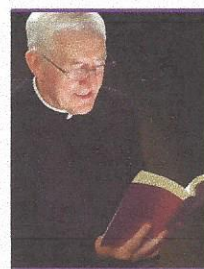
Be Smart. Stay Apart.

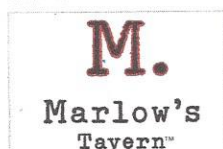

Dine-in or Take-out: When you return after golf or tennis, be aware that all serving stations will have boxes and supplies for take-out. Seating is available in the clubhouse, indoors and outside.

Golf Rules

PROCEDURE

- Each player will tee off and the best shot will be selected.
- The player who hit the selected tee shot must step aside and the other team members will hit the selected shot.
- Follow this procedure until you reach the green.
- Once on the green, ALL players will putt.

PLACEMENT

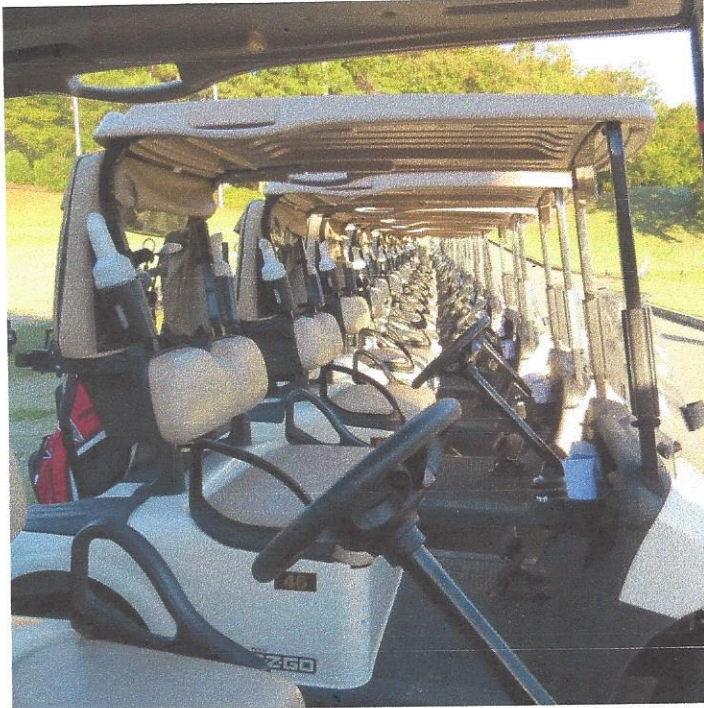
- Each team member may place the ball within one club-length of the selected shot, no nearer to the hole.
- If the selected shot is played from a hazard, bunker, rough, fairway or fringe of the green, then the team must play all the following shots from the same condition.

PUTTING

- Players are cautioned to avoid putting "tap-ins." Once the ball is holed, the hole is complete.
- The original putt may be moved a maximum of 2 inches from the mark, no nearer to the hole.

TIES

- In the event of a tie, a match of cards will take place beginning with hole #18, then #17, #16, etc.
