You are invited to join now for a bible study starting January 19 and 20. Walking with Purpose is a parish-based Bible study program for adult women. Run by local lay women volunteers, approved by parish pastors, and supported by Walking with Purpose national staff, our parish program welcomes all women irrespective of faith background, age, or marital status. The program incorporates at-home Scripture study, weekly small group discussion, and monthly talks on relevant study material. We hope you will prayerfully consider all options to see what fits into your life, but also what challenges you and refreshes you.

The study beginning in January will be an 11 weeks (lessons) study called *Fearless and Free*, based on the book of Ephesians. So many of us are wrestling through the reality that life isn't easy, even when we are doing the right thing. Suffering can slam into us from left field, leaving us reeling. This study provides a firm foundation to stand on no matter what life throws our way.

With an emphasis on healing and wholeness, **Fearless and Free** is the most personal and transformative study that Walking with Purpose offers, and there are two time options to fit your schedule:
