
Father Joe Corbett, founding pastor of Saint Brigid began the organizational meeting of Saint Vincent de Paul, with twenty parishioners. They had just learned that the mission of the society is to provide an environment for the personal spiritual growth and development of its members who in turn bring God's love to the suffering and deprived. The new conference and ministry at Saint Brigid was started with much enthusiasm.

Case workers in teams of two began meeting with clients who were referred or had called into the newly established hot line and also lived within the parish boundaries. Vincentian home visits help develop a trust with clients and an understanding of their personal situation and needs. Generous contributions from parishioners made and still makes it possible to help these new clients.


Meetings were and still are held twice a month, with spiritual development, conference business and case work discussion. In the early days a big portion of the meeting was spent on case work, how to help the clients and filling out paper work. As time progressed, guidelines were developed for client aid, a notebook of community resources was developed and a computer program was developed to track clients and services saving a lot of time and energy.

Today Vincentians meet virtually twice a month but hopefully will begin face to face meetings again soon.
