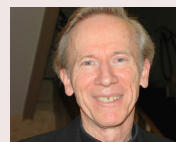

Golf Rules

PROCEDURE

- Each player will tee off and the best shot will be selected
- ALL golfers hit the next shot (no step aside)
- Follow the procedure until you reach the green
- Once on the green, all players putt
- If you miss a birdie putt, pick up and go to the next hole

PLACEMENT

- Each team member may place the ball within one club-length of the selected shot, no nearer to the hole.
- If the selected shot is played from a hazard, bunker, rough, fairway or fringe of the green, then the team must play all the following shots from the same condition.

PUTTING

- Players are cautioned to avoid putting "tap-ins." Once the ball is holed, the hole is complete.
- The original putt may be moved a maximum of 2 inches from the mark, no nearer to the hole.

TIES

- In the event of a tie, a match of cards will take place beginning with hole #18, then #17, #16, etc.

Women's Tee = Red

Live Scoring

The Golf Genius Live Scoring System is active in all carts, but scoring input is assigned to one person per foursome. Please keep paper scorecards and submit to double-check scores. Thanks to Steven Lindstrom and the CC of Roswell golf staff for organizing the competition and scorekeeping.

Weather Alerts

The Country Club of Roswell uses the Thor Guard Lightning Detection system. If the sirens go off, all golfers, tennis and pickleball players, sponsors and volunteers must return to the clubhouse immediately. **Should the event on May 9 need to be rescheduled the rain date for all activities is Monday, June 13, 2022.**

Tennis, Pickleball & Golf Awards

Tennis and Pickleball awards will be presented based on points accumulated during contests and competition. Golf awards will be presented to teams in first to fourth place, Putting Contest, Putting Playoff, Closest to the Pin and Longest Drive (women & men). Be sure to visit the main ballroom and look for prize results on the LED boards and listen to announcements made by DJ Dan Blankowski.

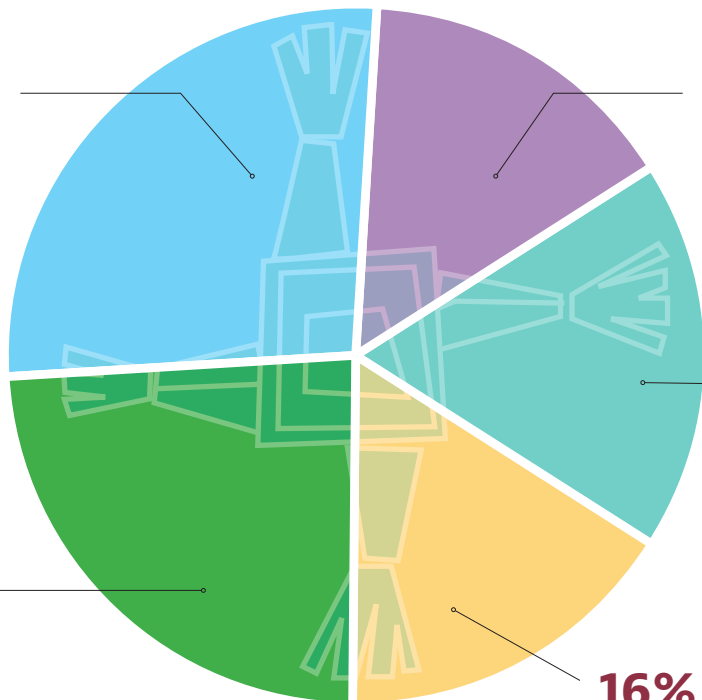
