



**DROP OFF is THURSDAY,
DECEMBER 5th – 2 pm to 7 pm
in the Saint Brigid parking lot**

The Saint Brigid staff has requested that sponsors adhere to the drop-off date. We are trying to limit the number of people handling gifts. If you will be out of town, please arrange for a friend or family member to bring them to the parking lot on December 5th.

- 1. Gifts should be NEW items, not Used.**
2. If you purchase a bike, please assemble and include a helmet (please put the helmet in a box or gift bag – **do not hang it on the bike**, as it is too easy to get separated from the bike).
Clearly and securely label with Delivery Site abbrev/Family# and total# of boxes and bikes (i.e. SB 865: 2 Boxes + 2 Bikes)
3. Please wrap all items (**except bikes**) and clearly label them with **the first name of the family member**. Gift cards should be put into an envelope or small box/gift bag.
4. **All wrapped gifts must be packed in boxes or large lawn bags (paper or plastic).**
 - Clearly mark packed boxes / large bags with Delivery Site/Family Number (found in top right-hand box of wish list), and Head of Household (also at top of wish list)
 - Each box should be numbered as follows: 1 of 2, 2 of 2, + bikes, if applicable (example: 1 of 2 boxes + 2 bikes)
 - If there are bikes, please label them with the Delivery Site abbrev/ Family number and include the number of boxes that go with it. Please attach the label securely with tape – **PLEASE DO NOT use hanging labels!**

Please drive up to the truck designated with your Delivery Site abbreviation. It is VERY IMPORTANT to have boxes/bikes labeled with Delivery Site (see below), FAMILY NUMBER, Head of Household, and NUMBER of BOXES/BIKES.
