## Monsignor Reynolds Charity Challenge Golf Scoring Rules 2025



## **During Registration**

We start with handicaps provided to us by the individual golfers and look up every golfer on the USGA website.

- If a golfer provides a whole number, we record what they give us (with a maximum of 30)
- If a golfer provides a USGA index, i.e., a number with a decimal point in it, we convert it to a handicap
- The handicap is based on white tees at Country Club of Roswell using the USGA Handicap Calculator
- https://www.usga.org/course-handicap-calculator.html
- The Handicap Calculator reflects the new USGA handicap rules implemented in 2020
- For the white tees at CCR, par is 71, course rating is 70.9, and slope is 137
- The calculator adds about 20% to an index given these parameters
- The head pro at CCR converts this information to a team handicap using the new USGA handicap rules established in 2020 for group handicaps
- For our format, the pro ranks the players as A, B, C, D based on individual handicaps (lowest to highest)
- The pro takes 25% of A's handicap, 20% of B's, 15% of C's, and 10% of D's to establish a team handicap

## Maximum Score, Mulligans, Birdies for Charities and Prizes

- The MRCC is a team competition using "Bogey is Your Buddy" scramble format
- That means highest score a team can record on a hole is Bogey
- Each team has four Mulligans which can be used tee-to-green for another shot attempt
- Each team also has the option to purchase up to four Birdies for Charities Tokens
- Limit one Token per golfer. Purchase Tokens at the Check-in Desk for \$50 each
- Each Token can be redeemed for one guaranteed Birdie on a hole the team selects
- The team can play the hole or skip the hole and still spend a Token to guarantee a Birdie
- Be sure to keep score on the Golf Genius system AND on written scorecards
- Submit all scorecards inside the clubhouse ballroom after play
- Team prizes will be awarded 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> place, Gross and Net

- Putting Contest after #9 (on practice green)
- Hole-in-One (#2, 7, 11)
- Closest to the pin on #16
- Longest Drive on #18
