Golf Rules

PROCEDURE

- Each player will tee off and the best shot will be selected.
- ALL golfers hit the next shot (no step aside).
- Follow the procedure until you reach the green.
- Once on the green, all players putt.
- If you miss a par putt, pick up and go to the next hole.

PLACEMENT

- Each team member may place the ball within one club-length of the selected shot, no nearer to the hole.
- If the selected shot is played from a hazard, bunker, rough, fairway or fringe of the green, then the team must play all the following shots from the same condition.

PUTTING

- Players are cautioned to avoid putting "tap-ins." Once the ball is holed, the hole is complete.
- The original putt may be moved a maximum of 2 inches from the mark, no nearer to the hole.

TIES

- In the event of a tie, a match of cards will take place beginning with hole #18, then #17, #16, etc.

MULLIGANS

- Each golfer has one mulligan to be used at his or her discretion to try and improve the team result on a hole.
- Mulligans cannot be used as part of contest attempt.

BIRDIES FOR CHARITIES

- Each golfer is offered the opportunity to purchase one Birdies-for-Charities token.
- If purchased, each token may be redeemed for a birdie on one golf hole selected by the team.

Pickleball

Pickleball remains the fastest growing participation sport in the USA and now is a popular component of the Charity Challenge. Pickleball at the Charity Challenge features 2.5 hours of court time, round-robin competition and all the evening activities back inside the clubhouse. Thanks to David Huntley and volunteers from Georgia Pickleball for help organizing the event again this year.

Men's Tee = White
Senior 65+ Tee = Green

To be eligible on Contest Holes, all men must use the White Tee

The Golf Genius Live Scoring System is active in all carts, but scoring input is assigned to one person per foursome. Please keep paper scorecards and submit to double-check scores. Please indicate the holes where a mulligan was used or where a Birdies-for-Charities token was used. Weather Alerts

The Country Club of Roswell uses the Thor Guard Lightning Detection system.
